Main Case

Petitioner Mukhwinder Singh seeks the benefit of regular bail in case F.I.R. No. 10 dated 5.3.2015 under Sections 498-A, 506, 316 I.P.C, registered at Police Station, Ghanie Ke Bangar, District Gurdaspur.

Counsel for the parties have been heard.

Complainant in this case is Amandeep Kaur i.e. Wife of the petitioner. Other co-accused are the mother-in-law namely Kiranjeet Kaur as also one Nachhatar Singh.

On the previous date of hearing i.e. 27.5.2015, this Court had taken notice of a submission made by counsel that co-accused had been granted interim bail and the matter had been referred to the Mediation & Conciliation Centre of this Court to explore the possibility of an amicable

settlement in relation to the matrimonial dispute. Accordingly, the present petitioner was granted interim bail for a period of 4 weeks to participate in the mediation proceedings.

Counsel for the petitioner as also for the complainant, during the course of hearing today, are ad idem that a compromise has been effected between the parties.

In the light of such categoric stand, prayer made in the present petition is allowed.

Petitioner be enlarged on bail subject to satisfaction of C.J.M./Duty Magistrate, Gurdaspur.
