TEJINDER SINGH DHINDSA.J.

The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.153, dated 18.06.2007, under Sections 325/324/323 IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar Khanna, District Ludhiana.

Counsel at the very outset prays that he may be permitted to withdraw the present petition. He, however, raises an additional submission that the petitioner would surrender before the trial Court within a period of one week from today and if, thereafter an application seeking regular bail is filed, the trial Court be directed to decide such bail application within a period of two days'.

As per prayer made by counsel, instant petition is dismissed as withdrawn.

It is, however, observed that in case, the petitioner duly surrenders before the trial Court within a period of one week from today and thereafter files an application seeking regular bail, such application would

be considered strictly on merits and the trial Court otherwise would make every endeavor to expedite the hearing and disposal of the same.
