Prayer in the present petition, filed under Section 439 of Cr.P.C, is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner during the pendency of the trial in case FIR No. 282, dated 26.07.2014 (Annexure P-1), for having committed the offence under Sections 304-B/34 IPC, registered at Police Station, Sadar Panipat, District-Panipat.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that co-accused of the petitioner, namely, Kishan Chand has already been granted regular bail by this Court vide order dated 04.05.2015 in CRM-M-No. 37759 of 2014, titled as **"Kishan Chand Vs. State of Haryana"**. He further submits that no incriminating evidence has come against the petitioner and all the witnesses have turned hostile. He also submits that his case is pari-materia to the case of **Kishan Chand(supra)**.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI-Ravinder Kumar, does not dispute the aforesaid fact.

Considering the fact that none of the witnesses i.e. the complainant or the father of the deceased have deposed against the petitioner, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner is admitted to regular bail subject to her furnishing of bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

However, it is made clear that the observations made here-in-above shall not be construed as reflection of any opinion on the merits of the main case, in any manner, during the course of trial, as the same has been recorded for a limited purpose of deciding the present petition for regular bail.
