Report dated 26.11.2015 sent by learned Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Malerkotla has been received, whereby, after recording statement of petitioner Rajinder Singh as well as of complainant Gur Lal Singh it has been informed that the parties have effected a compromise voluntarily on their free will and accord without any pressure.

Keeping in view that parties have effected a compromise which will go a long way to sort out the differences between them and in view of law laid down in **Gian Singh vs. State of Punjab and another 2012(4) RCR Criminal 543** and **Kulwinder Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and another 2007(3) RCR Criminal 1052**, FIR No.80 dated 05.06.2013 under Sections 406, 420, 120-B IPC, Police Station, City-I Malerkotla and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua the present petitioner.
