The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.81, dated 26.4.2015, registered under Sections 452, 354-A of the IPC, at Police Station Kotwali, Faridkot, District Faridkot.

Counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to the order dated 21.5.2015, the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for custodial investigation.

Learned Additional Advocate General, Punjab, on instructions from ASI Baljit Singh, does not deny the aforementioned facts.

Consequently, the order dated 21.5.2015 is made absolute, subject to the provisions of Section 438 of the Cr.P.C. The present petition stands disposed of accordingly.
