The instant petition was filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking issuance of directions to the official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners on the basis that they had entered into matrimony against the wishes of their elders.

While issuing notice of motion on 16.01.2015, this Court had granted liberty to the petitioners to approach the Senior Superintendent of Police, District SBS Nagar (Nawan Shaher) for protection in the light of instructions dated 10.08.2010 issued by the Home Department, State of Punjab.

Learned State counsel upon instructions from HC Kulwant Singh, P.S. Rahon, SBS Nagar (Nawan Shaher) would submit that the statements of both the petitioners have since been recorded and they have stated that they are happily staying together and are not in need of any police protection. This also perhaps explains the non-appearance of the counsel for the petitioners during the course of hearing today.

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In the light of categoric stand taken on behalf of the State,
no further directions are required to be passed.

The instant petition is disposed of as infructuous.
