Report dated 19.09.2015 sent by learned Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Sunam (Sangrur) has been received, whereby, after recording statements of petitioners Amrik Singh, Kaka Singh and Jiwan Singh @ Harjiwan Singh as well as of complainants Satnam Singh and Gurdeep Singh it has been informed that the parties have effected a compromise voluntarily on their free will and accord without any pressure.

Keeping in view that parties have effected a compromise which will go a long way to sort out the differences between them and in view of law laid down in **Gian Singh vs. State of Punjab and another 2012(4) RCR Criminal 543** and **Kulwinder Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and another 2007(3) RCR Criminal 1052**, FIR No.37 dated 23.02.2011 under Sections 452, 323,324,506,148,149 IPC, Police Station, City Sunam and all other consequential proceedings

arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua the present petitioners.
