Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.6 dated 28.1.2015 under Sections 323/324/326/452/148/149 IPC, registered at Police Station Tarsika, District Amritsar.

This Court, while issuing notice of motion for today, vide order dated 25.5.2015 had granted interim bail to the petitioners subject to their joining investigation and complying the provisions of Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that pursuant to order dated 25.5.2015, the petitioners have joined the investigation.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Jaspal

Singh, does not dispute this fact and states that the custodial interrogation of the petitioners is not required at this stage.

In view of the above, the present petition is allowed and the interim bail granted by this Court to the petitioners vide order dated 25.5.2015 is made absolute.

However, the petitioners shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
