Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for quashing of DDR No.24 dated 5.4.2011 under Sections 323, 324, 148, 149 IPC registered at Police Station Kabirpur, District Kapurthala (Annexure P-2) and subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, which is cross-version of FIR No.17 dated 4.4.2011 under Sections 323, 324, 148, 149 IPC registered at Police Station Kabirpur, District Kapurthala on the basis of compromise dated 1.5.2015 (Annexure P3).

In view of order passed today in CRM-M No.16961 of 2015, the present DDR No.24 dated 5.4.2011 under Sections 323, 324, 148, 149 IPC registered at Police Station Kabirpur, District Kapurthala (Annexure P-2) and subsequent proceedings arising therefrom are quashed, *qua* the

petitioners, on the basis of compromise dated 1.5.2015 (Annexure P3)
subject to payment of costs of Rs.5,000/-, to be desposited with the Punjab
State Legal Services Authority, Chandigarh.
