Prayer in this petition, filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 228, dated 09.04.2015, for offence under Sections 147, 148, 149, 307 IPC and Section 27/25/54/59 of the Arms Act, registered at Police Station, DLF Qutab Enclave, Gurgaon.

Learned Senior counsel appearing for the petitioner has argued that the present petitioner-Raghav Sachdeva has not caused any fire arm injury to the complainant-Anil Yadav son of Shri Shamsher Yadav. He further argued that the only allegation against the petitioner is that he has caused simple injury to the security guard, namely, Bali Ram. Even the co-accused, namely, Sunil Yadav against whom similar allegations have been made, has already been discharged by the police.

Learned State Counsel, on instructions from, ASI-Ashok Kumar, does not dispute the fact that the Sunil Yadav has been discharged by the police as well as petitioner has caused simple injury to the security guard, namely, Bali Ram.

Considering the fact that petitioner has not been attributed any injury which may attract the provisions of Section 307 IPC and has been attributed only simple injury, the present petition is allowed. Accordingly, the petitioner is admitted to regular bail, subject to his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court. The petitioner shall not influence the investigation/trial in any manner.
