Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.146 dated 18.04.2015, under Sections 61 of the Punjab Excise Act, 1914, registered at Police Station Division-A, District Amritsar.

While issuing notice of motion, following order was passed by this Court on 25.05.2015:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner, inter alia, submits that the petitioner was not apprehended from the place of occurrence nor the alleged illicit liquor was recovered from his conscious possession. The raid was conducted on the basis of secret information, still no independent witness was joined nor the information was reduced into writing. The place of occurrence was statedly densely populated area.

Notice of motion for 10.8.2015.

Meanwhile, in the event of arrest, petitioner

shall be admitted to interim bail, subject to the satisfaction of Arresting Officer. However, petitioner shall abide by the conditions incorporated under Section 438(2)Cr.P.C.”

Learned State counsel who is assisted by Head Constable Harjinder Singh has submitted that the petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for further investigation.

Accordingly, interim bail granted by this Court to the petitioner vide order dated 25.05.2015, is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
