JASPAL SINGH, J. (Oral)

This is a petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of pre-arrest bail moved by Babbal-petitioner, feeling apprehension of his arrest, in case bearing FIR No. 135, dated 25.12.2014, under Sections 380 and 511 of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station City Fazilka.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI, Amarjit Singh has submitted that petitioner has already joined the investigation on January 31, 2015, in compliance of order dated January 19, 2015, passed by this Court and he is no more required for further investigation.

Accordingly, order dated January 19, 2015, is made

absolute, subject to the following conditions prescribed under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C:-

- (i) *a condition that the petitioner shall make himself available for interrogation by a police officer as and when required;*
- (ii) *a condition that the petitioner shall not, directly or indirectly, make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer;*
- (iii) *a condition that the petitioner shall not leave India without the previous permission of the Court.*
