Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.419 dated 18.10.2014, under Sections 148, 149, 323, 341, 356, 506 and 307 of Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Saran, Faridabad.

While issuing notice of motion, following order was passed by this Court on 03.07.2015:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that complainant party, comprising of complainant, Pardeep son of Rajender, Hardeep and Pardeep sons of Vikram Singh, were stopped by the accused, namely, Kishan, Vikas and Binni, while they were returning after purchase of vegetables on 17.10.2014 at about 9.00 P.M. Accused gave injuries to all the four persons. Pardeep son of Rajender fell down. When the complainant party tried to pick him up, accused Kishan called other persons, namely, Gopal, Radhey, Sonu, Tikku and Man Singh (petitioner). Allegations are that

all these persons gave beatings to Pardeep son of Rajender.

Learned counsel further states that the petitioner was operated on 16.10.2014 at Palwal for calculus in his kidney. No specific role has been attributed to the petitioner, nor he was shown armed with any weapon. Occurrence is stated to have taken place on 17.10.2014 at 9.00 P.M., whereas, FIR came to be recorded on 18.10.2015 at about 4.40 P.M.

Notice of motion for 28.8.2015.

Meanwhile, in the event of arrest, petitioner shall be admitted to interim bail, subject to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer. However, petitioner shall abide by the conditions incorporated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned State counsel who is assisted by Assistant Sub Inspector Ram Babu has submitted that petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for further investigation.

Accordingly, interim bail granted to the petitioner by this Court vide order dated 03.07.2015, is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
