Instant petition has been filed seeking directions to learned trial Court to release the petitioner on bail on his appearance before it.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner *inter-alia* contends that petitioner has been facing trial before Judge, Special Court, Hoshiarpur in case FIR No. 38 dated May 20, 2014 under Section 15 of NDPS Act registered at Police Station Haryana, District Hoshiarpur. He further contends that since the petitioner has been suffering from loose motion, fever and cold and had gone to Civil Hospital, Haryana for treatment on April 18, 2015 as a result of which he could not appear before learned trial Court on April 22, 2015 due to which his bail orders were cancelled to the State and he has been summoned through non-bailable warrants of arrest.

4. On the asking of Court, Mr. J.S. Sekhon, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State of Punjab. Copy of the petition be supplied to learned State counsel during the course of day.

Instant petition is disposed of with a direction to learned trial Court that in case petitioner surrenders before it within a period of 7 days from the receipt of certified copy of this order, he shall be released on bail to its satisfaction and at the same time in case of his non-appearance before it on subsequent date(s), learned trial Court shall be competent to cancel its bail order.
