Report dated 15.06.2015 sent by learned Judicial Magistrate, 1st Class, Malerkotla (Sangrur) has been received, whereby, after recording statement of the petitioners Mohd. Yaseen @ Peter, Mohd. Iftkhar @ Raj Kasai, Karamjit Singh @ Kammi, Mohd, Ishrar, Mohd Illiyas and Deepak Kumar as well as of complainant Mukesh Kumar it has been informed that the parties have effected a compromise voluntarily on their free will and accord without any pressure.

Keeping in view that both the sides are residents of the same very area and that this compromise will go a long way to sort out the differences between them together with the fact that injury alleged to have been given is on the non-vital part i.e. arm and in view of law laid down in **Gian Singh vs. State of Punjab and another 2012(4) RCR Criminal 543** and **Kulwinder Singh**

and others vs. State of Punjab and another 2007(3) RCR

Criminal 1052, FIR No.112 dated 20.10.2014 under Sections 308, 325, 341, 506, 148, 149 IPC Police Station, City Malerkotla, District Sangrur and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua the petitioners.

Petition stands disposed off.
