Petitioners seek quashing of FIR No.215 dated 10.08.2009, under Sections 323, 324, 325, 34 IPC registered at Police Station Banga, SBS Nagar on the basis of compromise.

The said FIR was registered at the instance of respondent No.2 Kehar Singh alleging that the petitioners armed with various weapons had given beatings to the complainant.

Parties were directed to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate to get their statements recorded regarding the compromise. After recording the statements of the parties, a report has been received to the effect that the matter has been compromised voluntarily without any threat, coercion or undue influence.

Following the full Bench judgment of this Court in **Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab and others, 2007 (3) R.C.R. (Criminal) 1052**, the petition is allowed. The aforesaid FIR and all the

criminal proceedings emanating therefrom are hereby quashed on the basis of compromise subject to petitioners depositing a total sum of Rs.5,000/- with Punjab State Legal Services Authority, Sector 22 Chandigarh and another total sum of Rs. 5,000/- with Punjab Police Welfare Fund, Sector 9, Chandigarh, within a period of one month.
