The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.26 dated 16.02.2015, registered under Sections 341, 323, 148, 149 IPC (Section 307 IPC added later on), Police Station Samana, District Patiala.

Heard.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the injury under Section 307 IPC is not attributed to the petitioners nor the fact is recorded in the complaint made with the police by complainant Jasvir Kaur.

Learned State counsel informs that statement of Bachittar Singh has not been recorded as there is a cross version and he has not been arrested yet.

On perusal of the record, I find that some other accused have approached the Court for anticipatory bail and the matter is fixed in the month of August, 2015 and the challan has not been presented so far.

The trial will take long time to conclude. Without commenting upon the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and the petitioners are directed to be released on regular bail on execution of adequate personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of Illaqa/Duty Magistrate.
