Learned State counsel states that the addresses of both the petitioners and respondent no.4 could not be verified.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that petitioners have got married on 18.05.2015 and copy of their marriage certificate is available on record as Annexure P-3. Petitioner no.2 is a minor.

The petitioners have submitted a representation dated 19.05.2015, Annexure P-4 to respondent no.2.

The petition is disposed of with a direction to the petitioners to approach respondent no.2 i.e. the Commissioner of Police, Amritsar who would look into the allegation and take steps in accordance with law if situation so warrants.

This order shall not be construed to be conferring legitimacy or authenticity to the factum of marriage having been performed as the Court is clearly deprived of any means to determine the facts.
