Affidavit of petitioner No.2- Ravi Kumar and marriage certificate, filed in the Court is taken on record.

Shweta and Ravi Kumar, the petitioners before me, claim themselves to be major. They have pleaded that they have married against the wishes of respondent No.4 and seek protection to their life and liberty. They apprehend danger from respondent No.4. They have placed on record marriage certificate and photographs (Annexure P-3). The petitioners have also submitted a representation (Annexure P-4) to respondent No.3, with a copy to respondent No.2.

Without commenting upon the legality of the marriage and entering upon an exercise to evaluate the evidentiary value of the documents placed on the file, I dispose of the petition with directions to respondent No.2 to decide the representation of the petitioners, within a period of one month and grant the protection, if any threat to their life and liberty is perceived. It is made clear that this order shall not be taken to protect the petitioners from legal action for violation of law, if any, committed by them.
