Ranjit Kaur @ Rani, Jagir Kaur and Piara Singh have filed this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in respect of FIR No.143 dated 02.12.2013, under Section 304-B read with Section 34 IPC, Police Station Anandpur Sahib, District Roopnagar.

So far as the accused-Ranjit Kaur @ Rani is concerned, her application for anticipatory bail has already been accepted vide CRM-M No.1217 of 2014 and as such, she is not required to file afresh application for anticipatory bail.

So far as the other accused, namely, Jagir Kaur and Piara Singh are concerned, their application for anticipatory bail has been dismissed on merits vide CRM-M of 1217 of 2014 decided on 14.03.2014.

Counsel for Jagir Kaur and Piara Singh has submitted that they have been declared innocent and have been summoned under Section 319 Cr.P.C. and as such, they are entitled for concession of anticipatory bail.

I have considered the said submission, but do not find any force in that submission.

The prayer of Jagir Kaur and Piara Singh for grant of anticipatory bail has been declined on merits on 14.03.2014 and mere declaring them as innocent during the course of investigation is not a ground for grant of anticipatory bail.

Consequently, the petition qua Jagir Kaur and Piara Singh stands declined.
