Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that he be allowed to withdraw the present petition with liberty to the petitioners to raise all their pleas before the trial court. He, however, prays that personal appearance of petitioner No.2, who is a lady of 60 years of age, may be exempted before the trial court.

In view of the statement made by learned counsel for the petitioner, this petition is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as aforesaid. In case the petitioner No.2 moves an application for exemption of her personal appearance, same shall be considered by the trial court in accordance with law. The trial court may exempt the personal appearance of petitioner No.2 on such terms and conditions, as it deems proper to impose. This petitioner may be allowed to appear through her counsel except on the dates when her presence is necessary.
