This is a petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking pre-arrest bail to petitioners in a case registered against them vide FIR No.66 dated 28.02.2015 under Sections 498-A/406/506 and 323 IPC at Police Station Farakpur, Distt. Yamuna Nagar.

According to learned counsel for the petitioners, as directed by this Court vide its order dated July 16, 2015, son of the petitioner is present in Court.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Subhash Chand, submits that pursuant to order dated May 25, 2015, the petitioners have joined the investigation and are no longer required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the statement made by learned State counsel, the interim order dated May 25, 2015, is hereby made absolute, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Amount of ₹20,000/- deposited with the registry be remitted to the trial court. Same be released to complainant-Kiran Devi on an application being moved by her.

The petition stands allowed in aforesaid terms.
