Petitioners have filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.112 dated 30.04.2015, under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471, 447, 511, 120-B of Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Sultanwind, District Amritsar City.

Following order was passed by this Court on 05.06.2015:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that in a civil suit filed by petitioner No.1 – Rajwant Kaur, interim stay has been granted by the trial court on 02.05.2015 in respect to the suit property. It is further submitted that custodial interrogation of the petitioners is not required as the entire case is based on documentary evidence. Petitioners are ready and willing to join investigation as and when required by the investigating agency.

Learned counsel for the State submits that Jamabandi itself, on the basis of which sale-deeds have been executed are forged and fabricated. Petitioners have not joined investigation in this case.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances, petitioners are directed to appear before the Investigating Officer on or before 09.06.2015 at 11.00 a.m. and on any subsequent date as may be required by the investigating agency and cooperate. In the event of arrest, petitioners shall be released on interim bail by the Arresting/Investigating Officer to his satisfaction. The petitioners shall comply with the conditions stipulated in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Adjourned to 06.07.2015.”

Learned State counsel who is assisted by Assistant Sub Inspector Madan Singh has submitted that the petitioners have joined investigation and are not required for further investigation.

Accordingly, interim bail granted by this Court to the petitioners vide order dated 05.06.2015, is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
