Prayer is for quashing the FIR No. 124, dated 04.10.2012 (**Annexure P-1**) for the offences under Sections 465, 467, 468, 471, 420 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, registered with Police Station City, Hoshiarpur and all subsequent proceedings on the basis of compromise as reflected in the affidavits dated 26.04.2011 (**Annexure P-2 and P-3**) arrived at between the parties.

Reply has been filed by the complainant, denying the compromise.

It is further apparent that there is one other accused, namely, Jaswinder Kaur, who is not a party in the present petition whereas the petitioners are seeking partial compromise.

In view of the fact that there is a partial compromise, no case of quashing the aforesaid FIR is made out.

Accordingly, the present petition stands dismissed.
