**ANITA CHAUDHRY, J. (ORAL)**

This petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No. 245 dated 04.10.2014 registered at Police Station Shahkot, Jalandhar, District Jalandhar under Sections 22, 61, 85 of the NDPS Act.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that petitioner is in custody since 04.10.2014 and not a single witness has been examined.

Learned State counsel informed that charge was framed on 14.05.2015. Status report had been called in July, 2015 but the same has not been submitted yet. He states that there were two more cases against the petitioner but those had ended in acquittal.

Without commenting on the merits of the case and considering the fact that the trial will take time to conclude, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing adequate bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court subject to the condition that he will not indulge himself in any such activity during the period of trial.
