MAHESH GROVER, J.

This is a petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. praying for release of the petitioner on bail in terms thereof in a case registered vide FIR No.202 dated 2.9.2014 under Sections 409, 420 IPC at Police Station Samrala, District Khanna (Ludhiana).

Even though number of offences were arrayed against the petitioner, he is facing only under Sections 409 and 420 IPC. He has been in custody since 5.10.2014. It is the case of the petitioner that keeping in view the long incarceration and the delay in trial he deserves the concession of bail.

Learned counsel for the respondent-State contends that the allegations against the petitioner are serious and he is said to have siphoned off a huge amount of money i.e. Rs.33,45,000/-.

Be that as it may, considering the fact that the petitioner is in custody since 5.10.2014 and the trial is likely to take some time,

without commenting on the merits of the case, I direct the release of the petitioner under Section 439 Cr.P.C.

Bail to the satisfaction of Trial Court/Duty Magistrate,
Ludhiana.

Petition stands allowed.
