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**M.M.S. BEDI, J (ORAL)**

Through the instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C., the petitioner seeks a direction for protection of life and liberty on the ground that the respondent No.4 is running his chemist shop near the shop of the petitioner and that on 6.2.2012, the petitioner was assaulted by some drug addicts. Petitioner claims that no action has been taken on the basis of his complaint on account of influence of respondent No.4.

I have gone through the facts and circumstances of the case. The main reliance of the petitioner is on the MLR (Annexure P6) indicating that he has received certain injuries. The petitioner claims that he has filed a representation to SSP, Sangrur (Annexure P8). Learned counsel for respondent No.4 informs that the petitioner

has already filed a private complaint against respondent No.4.

In view of the petitioner having already availed remedy, it does not appear to be a case of grant of any protection. However, it is observed that in case there is no imminent threat to the life and liberty of the petitioner, it will be open to him to move an application before SSP, Sangrur.

Disposed of with liberty as aforesaid.
