MAHESH GROVER, J.

This order will dispose of two criminal petitions bearing CRM no. M-17315 and 20977 of 2015.

The petitioners pray for grant of regular bail in terms of Section 439 Cr.P.C in cross case registered under Sections 307, 325, 323, 148, 149 IPC and Sections 25, 27, 54, 59 of Arms Act in FIR no. 71 dated 8.8.2014 registered under Sections 302, 307, 148, 149 IPC and Sections 25, 27, 54, 59 Arms Act at Police Station, Rangar Nangal, District Gurdaspur.

The facts would indicate a free fight between the petitioners and the complainant. In the present FIR, two persons from the complainants' side are said to have died on account of fire arm injuries.

Petitioner in CRM no.M-17315 of 2015 namely Gurcharan Singh @ Sonu is said to be armed with a dang and is alleged to have given simple injury on the person of one Gurmukh Singh while petitioner in CRM no.M-20977 of 2015 namely Balraj Singh @ Baja is said to have caused simple injury with a base ball bat to one Harpinder Singh. Both the petitioners are in custody since 16.10.2014.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that only simple injuries have been attributed to them and some persons have been released on bail considering their limited or insignificant role in the occurrence.

Learned State counsel has opposed the bail application on the ground of serious nature of allegations.

On due consideration of the matter and noticing the fact that petitioner namely Gurcharan Singh @ Sonu is said to have given simple injury on the head while petitioner namely Balraj Singh @ Baja is also said to have given simple injury with blunt weapons and they are in custody since 16.10.2014, instant petitions are accepted. It is directed that the petitioners be released on bail in terms of Section 439 Cr.P.C . Bail to the satisfaction of learned Trial Court.

Nothing said herein shall be construed to be an expression on the merits of the case.
