On 22.04.2015, Additional Sessions Judge, Gurdaspur, directed the petitioner to surrender by 24.04.2015 and the order was passed in the presence of his counsel.

It is submitted that the counsel did not inform the petitioner, who was to come from district Mandi (Himachal Pradesh). Therefore, the petitioner could not surrender on the next date fixed before the said Court. Even the counsel did not appear.

The petitioner had applied for exemption for one date which was declined and warrant of arrest was issued.

It is stated that the trial is at the final stage. The petitioner is, therefore, directed to appear before the trial Court on 30.05.2015 and the trial Court shall admit her to bail to its satisfaction.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
