Pursuant to the mediation proceedings, the matter has been amicably resolved.

Learned counsel for the complainant has stated that the terms of the compromise are yet to be implemented.

The petition is allowed. It is ordered that in case of arrest of petitioner, he will be released on bail to the satisfaction of the arresting officer subject to the following conditions:

- (1) Petitioner will join investigation as and when required;
- (2) Petitioner will comply with the terms of the compromise by ensuring that the amount due to the complainant, as agreed to between the parties on 04.11.2015, is paid on the specified dates and the other acts are performed; and

- (3) Petitioner will not leave India without the permission of the Court till the pendency of the FIR.

In case of violation of any of the conditions, it will be open to the complainant to approach this Court for cancellation of the bail.
