Prayer made in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.56, dated 06.03.2015, under Sections 420, 419 and 406 read with Section 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station City, Barnala, District Barnala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the order dated 25.05.2015 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI-Ajaib Singh, submits that the petitioner has joined investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required at this stage.

In view of the above, the present petition is allowed and order dated 25.05.2015 passed by this Court is made absolute.

However, petitioner shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
