Service has been effected upon respondents no.3 to 8 but there is no appearance on their behalf. Notices issued to respondents no.9 & 10 have not been received back served or otherwise.

Learned State counsel informs that statements of mother of the girl and father of the boy have been recorded and they have no objection.

Both the petitioners before me, claim themselves to be major and seek protection as they apprehend danger from respondents no.3 to 10.

Petitioner no.1 is Muslim while petitioner no.2 is a Sikh.

The petition is disposed of with a direction to the petitioners to approach respondent no.2 i.e. Superintendent of Police, Amritsar who would look into the allegation and take steps in accordance with law if situation so warrants.

This order shall not be construed to be conferring legitimacy or authenticity to the factum of marriage having been performed as the Court is clearly deprived of any means to determine the facts.
