This is a petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for quashing FIR No. 30, dated 16.05.2007, under Sections 420, 465, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Badhni Kalan, District Moga, on the basis of compromise, along with all subsequent proceedings arising from that FIR.

Complainant is not present.

Report has been received in which it is mentioned that parties have arrived at a compromise.

Learned counsel for the complainant has also made a statement before this Court that FIR be quashed alongwith Sukhwinder Singh also. The affidavit of the complainant has also been placed on record in this regard.

So, in view of the above circumstances and in view of authority reported as, "**Kulwinder Singh and others vs. State of Punjab**

and others” 2007 (3) RCR (Criminal) 1052, the above said FIR stands quashed. Further proceedings in pursuant to that FIR alongwith order of declaring Sukhwinder Singh as proclaimed offender also stands quashed.
