MAHESH GROVER, J.

The petitioner prays for grant of pre-arrest bail in terms of Section 438 Cr.P.C in case FIR no. 327 dated 22.4.2014 registered under Sections 420, 406, 323, 506, 34 IPC at Police Station City Hisar, District Hisar.

The petitioner is alleged to have duped number of people into parting with money on the pretext of providing them jobs. Thereafter, he had given five cheques but all of them bounced. The petitioner pleaded inter se business dealings and thus a civil dispute.

On due consideration of the matter, I find that the allegations against the petitioner are serious and would require sustained investigation to unravel the entire network of the people involved in cheating people on the pretext of providing them jobs. The petitioner was given an opportunity to settle equities by returning the amount to the effected persons which offer

the petitioner has spurned despite several opportunities. Therefore, no ground to exercise jurisdiction under Section 438 Cr.P.C in favour of the petitioner is made out.

Hence, dismissed.
