Petitioners seek quashing of FIR No.173 dated 18.12.2013, under Sections 452, 427, 148, 149 IPC registered at Police Station E Division, District Amritsar City on the basis of compromise. The said FIR was registered at the instance of respondent No.2 Sanjay Mehra alleging that the petitioners along with others had trespassed the house of the complainant.

It appears that only two accused have been arrayed as petitioners in the petition.

On the instructions from SI Randhir Singh, it has been informed that only two persons have been named by the complainant and no other accused has been arrayed besides the petitioners.

Parties were directed to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate to make statement regarding the compromise. A report has been received after recording the statements of the parties that the matter has been compromised voluntarily, without any fear or pressure.

Following the full Bench judgment of this Court in **Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab and others 2007 (3) RCR (Criminal) 1052**, the petition is allowed. The aforesaid FIR and all the criminal proceedings emanating therefrom are hereby quashed on the basis of compromise.
