Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 CrPC is for issuance of directions to respondents no.1 to 3 to ensure the liberty and security of the petitioner, as the respondents no.4 and 5 are proposing for her marriage with some illiterate person.

Learned counsel for respondents no.4 and 5, on instructions from respondents no.4 and 5, who are parents of the petitioner and are present in Court, submits that respondents no.4

and 5 will not pressurize the petitioner to get her married against her wishes.

Accordingly, this petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent no.2 to take decision on the representation dated 15.5.2015 (Annexure P5) submitted by the petitioner, in accordance with law and to ensure that no harm is caused to the petitioner.
