Report dated 28.11.2014 sent by learned Judicial Magistrate, 1st Class Sri Muktsar Sahib has been received, whereby, after recording statements of petitioner Navpreet Kaur @ Mandeep Kaur as well as of complainant Gurpreet Singh it has been informed that the parties have effected a compromise voluntarily on their free will and accord without any pressure.

and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom are hereby
quashed qua the present petitioner. However, the proceedings against
the co-accused shall proceed as per law.
