By filing the present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioner has sought anticipatory bail in case FIR No.95, dated 07.04.2014, registered under Sections 419, 420, 467, 468 and 120-B IPC, at Police Station City, Tarn Taran.

It is contended that there is no direction allegations against the petitioner in the FIR. He is not the beneficiary from the alleged execution of power of attorney. Moreover, nothing is to be recovered from the petitioner.

Heard.

There are direct allegations against the petitioner that he in connivance with other co-accused has impersonated the complainant by executing a power of attorney on the basis of forged

documents and later on transferred the land of the complainant.

Keeping in view the key role of the petitioner, the Court is not inclined to grant the concession sought at this stage.

Dismissed.
