Mandeep Singh appears to have filed a complaint against the petitioner alleging that he in connivance with other accused had cheated him to the tune of Rs.21,00,000/- by giving an assurance of sending him abroad. The petitioner seeks a direction to the officials respondents to hand over the investigation in FIR No.57 dated 08.04.2015 under Section 420/120-B IPC registered at Police Station Sadar, Amritsar to Crime Branch or any other independent agency.

Petitioner claims that he is a Nihang Sikh and is in the business of Timber and Mandeep Singh got a timber work done in his house from the petitioner. He has transferred some amount to the petitioner, however, sum of Rs.3,00,000/- is still due against the petitioner.

On instructions from ASI Baldev Singh, State counsel informs that the complaint of the petitioner Annexure P-2 and the allegations of the complainant Mandeep Singh in the FIR are being looked into fairly. It has been informed that matter appears to have been compromised between the parties.

This petition is disposed of with a direction to the Commissioner of Police, Amritsar (Rural) to fairly supervise the inquiry/investigation pending and ensure that the inquiry is conducted in accordance with rules and law and none of the parties is unnecessarily harassed. Matter be inquired expeditiously preferably within a period of three to six months.
