The petitioner has been charged under Section 29 of the NDPS Act along with his co-accused Raman Kumar and Ranjit Singh.

Co-accused of the petitioner having been granted concession of bail on the ground that charge has been framed only under Section 29 of the NDPS Act, in view of similar circumstances, the petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court subject to the condition that he will furnish an affidavit before his release that he will not commit similar offence of which he is accused of during pendency of the trial.
