Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for quashing of FIR No.137 dated 4.3.2015 under Sections 406, 498-A, 323 and 506 IPC, registered at Police Station Karnal Civil Lines, District Karnal.

The petitioners are father-in-law and mother-in-law of respondent No.3 Vena, who was married with Prince Gupta on 26.1.2006.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Shiv Charan, submits that during the course of investigation, the petitioners have been found innocent and accordingly, their names have been mentioned in column No.2. He further submits that the Challan has been presented only against the husband of respondent No.3.

Learned counsel for respondents No.2 and 3 submits that the petitioners have been found innocent as the police has not conducted the investigation properly.

Taking into consideration the fact that the Challan has been presented and the petitioners have been found innocent, the present petition is rendered infructuous and the same is disposed of as such.
