Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.85 dated 18.04.2013, under Sections 120, 420, 467, 468, 471 of Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Rania, District Sirsa (Haryana).

While issuing notice of motion, following order was passed by this Court on 26.05.2015:-

“Contends that the petitioner's role is of identification of the purchaser in a sale deed which is said to have been fraudulently obtained by impersonation. Further contends that the police in its inquiry has found the petitioner innocent but the Court has now summoned him pursuant to the powers under Section 190(1) Cr.P.C.

Notice of motion for 14.8.2015.

In the meantime, the arrest of the petitioner shall remain stayed subject to the following conditions :-

- i) He will make himself available for investigation as and when required to do so.*
- ii) He will not leave the country without the prior permission of the Court.*
- iii) He will not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police official.”*

Learned State counsel who is assisted by Head Constable Rajender Prasad has submitted that the petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for further investigation.

Accordingly, interim bail granted by this Court to the petitioner vide order dated 26.05.2015, is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
