Petitioner seeks concession of regular bail alleging false implication and conversion of a case of accident into a case of homicide.

Without entering into the merits of the case, it is sufficient to observe that all the prosecution witnesses have already been examined and cross-examined. The case is at the stage of final arguments and fixed for 23.01.2015. Believing that expression of opinion at this stage might prejudice the adjudication of the trial on merits, this petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to raise all the pleas taken in this petition and take advantage if any on the basis of benefit of doubt as claimed. In case the trial is not finally decided within one month after 23.01.2015, it will be open to the petitioner to seek concession of bail by approaching this Court again.
