Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.386 dated 24.12.2007, under Sections 379, 467, 468, 471, 420, 120-B of Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Focal Point, District Ludhiana.

Following order was passed by this Court on 13.08.2015:-

"Learned State counsel requests for an adjournment.

List again on 06.10.2015.

In the meantime, petitioner is directed to surrender before the Trial Court and the Trial Court shall release the petitioner on interim bail subject to its satisfaction."

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that in pursuance to the above order, petitioner has surrendered before the trial Court on 25.08.2015 and has furnished the necessary bail bonds.

Accordingly, the interim bail furnished by the petitioner, before the trial Court, in pursuance to the order dated 13.08.2015 passed by this Court, is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
