Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.218 dated 13.10.2014, under Sections 419, 420, 465, 467, 468, 471, 120-B of Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Dakha, District Ludhiana Rural.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the co-accused Gurmit Singh of the petitioner has already been allowed anticipatory bail by this Court vide order dated 23.07.2015.

Learned State counsel who is assisted by Sub Inspector Baljinder Singh has submitted that the petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for further investigation.

Accordingly, this petition is allowed. In the event of

arrest, petitioner be released on bail subject to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer. Petitioner is directed to join investigation as and when required by the police and shall not tamper with the prosecution evidence. Petitioner shall not leave the Country without prior permission of the Court.
