**Crl. Misc. No.M-1751 of 2015**

This is second petition filed seeking regular bail in FIR No.93 dated 19.11.2013, registered under Sections 406, 420 IPC, Police Station Haryana, District Hoshiarpur.

Heard.

The accusation against the petitioner and one Sohan Singh is that they had received Rs.3,00,000/- from the complainant to get the job in lieu of which the complainant was allegedly taken to Calcutta.

On the last date, the State was asked to file a status report and inform the number of witnesses who have been examined. Petitioner as well as the State have filed the copy of the zimni orders. A perusal thereof

show that the accused had not been produced from jail on number of dates. Charge had been framed on 05.12.2014. Though, the case was fixed for prosecution evidence for three dates but not a single witness has been examined. The reason is that the accused was not produced by the jail authorities. The trial is not proceeding. The petitioner is in custody since July, 2014. Without commenting upon the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail on execution of adequate personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court.
