SABINA, J

Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.6 dated 23.01.2014, under Sections 406, 420 of Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Kathgarh, District Saheed Bhagat Singh Nagar.

While issuing notice of motion, following order was passed by this Court on 26.05.2015:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner inter alia submits that as per allegation in the FIR, an amount of Rs.15 lacs as earnest money was paid to Sajjan Kumar who promised the same to be paid to other shareholders. Now the compromise has been effected by the complainant with Sajjan Kumar to the exclusion of others by saying that Sajjan Kumar neither received any amount from complainant Ajit Singh nor any deal was struck.

*Learned counsel further relies upon order dated 09.02.2015 and 27.03.2015 passed in **CRM-M***

No.2472 of 2015 in respect of co-accused Sethi Kumar and others.

Notice of motion for 13.08.2015.

Meanwhile, in the event of arrest, petitioner shall be admitted to interim bail, subject to the satisfaction of Arresting Officer. However, petitioner shall abide by the conditions incorporated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned State counsel who is assisted by Head Constable Ram Shah has submitted that the petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for further investigation.

Accordingly, interim bail granted by this Court to the petitioner vide order dated 26.05.2015, is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
