The petition stands disposed off with the direction to the official respondents No.2 and 3 to immediately consider the representation of the petitioners (Annexure P7) and to dispose off the same within the framework of law within a period of 15 days and further the official respondents to ensure safety to the personal lives and liberty of the petitioners by taking appropriate steps in this regard and shall also ensure that the petitioners are not harassed at odd hours or unnecessarily called to the Police Station without adopting

legitimate process of law. However, the petitioners shall be at liberty to move this Court in case of any eventuality, if so arises.
