Petitioner's grievance is relating to settlement of pensionary benefits along with interest @ 20 % per annum. He has retired on 31.10.1995 and present writ petition was filed in the year 1996. After receipt of the notice of this writ petition on 27.06.1997, a sum of ₹ 29,368/- has been disbursed. The same was accepted by the petitioner under protest. If any other dues which are due to the petitioner, the same shall be paid to him within a period of four weeks

so also interest on belated settlement of pensionary benefits @ 9 %
per annum.

Accordingly, the writ petition is disposed of.
