This is a petition preferred under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (for short, 'Code') seeking directions to respondents No. 2 and 3 to register a cross-version case against the accused, under appropriate sections, in case bearing FIR No. 105, dated 29.08.2014, under Sections 323, 452, 506 and 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Sector 19, Panchkula, District Panchkula against the petitioner (Annexure P-2) and for taking action in respect of the representations moved by the petitioner.

2. Notice of motion.

3. At the asking of the Court, Mr. Vikas Chopra, DAG, Haryana has accepted notice on behalf of respondents-State. Copy of the petition has been supplied to learned State counsel.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that though representations to Station House Officer, Police Station Sector 20, Panchkula as well as Deputy Commissioner of Police, Panchkula were moved, which are (Annexures P-3 and P-4) but no action so far has been taken.

5. Accordingly, present petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No.2-Deputy Commissioner of Police, Panchkula to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in his representations (Annexures P-3 and P-4) and if some substance is found, to take appropriate action as required under law within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
